

Realignment 2012-2014

The TAPPS Executive Board convened for the scheduled meeting on September 21, 2011 to determine the schools alignment for the 2012-2014 school years. In conjunction with the Academic Executive Committee and Athletic Executive Committee, the material posted on the TAPPS website and outlined below was approved for the 2012-2014 school years.

The TAPPS staff presented the group with a list of membership averages as submitted by TAPPS member schools based on Boys Only enrollment, Girls Only enrollment, and Average Total enrollment. The Executive Board and Committees reviewed and affirmed the continued use of five classifications for the coming realignment period.

The Executive Board, with input from the committees, then reviewed proposals for the general alignment of schools. The Executive Board assigned General Classification Alignments based on the Average Total enrollment after discussion and comparison. In 11 Man Football, the Average Total Enrollment was used to determine school placement in classifications. Division I will remain only 5A schools with the remaining schools distributed into Division II and III.

For Swim/Dive and Winter Soccer, the Divisions are assigned as Division I (5A), Division II (4A) and Division III (3A, 2A, 1A). For Football the Divisions are assigned as Division I (5A), Division II and Division III.

Realignment 2012-2014

The TAPPS Executive Board unanimously approved for the 2012 – 2014 school years.

5A Enrollment Average 391 and above

4A Enrollment Average 191 - 390

3A Enrollment Average 106 – 190

2A Enrollment Average 60 – 105

1A Enrollment Average 59 and below

6 Man Football

(Based on Average Boys Enrollment)

1A-2A-3A Schools are eligible to participate in Six Man Football. Schools with a Boys Only enrollment of more than 77 are not eligible to participate in Six Man Football.

Schools were placed in division in accordance with the reported Average Boys Enrollment.
