

- A. In the event that any civil judicial action, including a TRO (Temporary Restraining Order) is taken against TAPPS or decision made under the TAPPS Constitution and/or By-Laws, any TAPPS Executive Board Member, any member of TAPPS Fine Arts Executive Committee, Athletic Executive Committee or any ad hoc committees, TAPPS Member School, TAPPS President or any other TAPPS officer, the following action may be taken, including but not limited by the following reprimands:
1. stripping awards from teams and/or individual;
 2. probation of the individual student seeking civil judicial action and/or the TAPPS member school he/she attends;
 3. disqualification of the individual student seeking civil judicial action for a full year from the conclusion of the legal action;
 4. full team disqualification of up to a full year from the conclusion of the legal action;
- B. A TAPPS Member School employee or volunteer of a member school, or student or parent of a student of a TAPPS Member School which files a lawsuit or any other legal action, which must be defended shall reimburse TAPPS, TAPPS Executive Board Member, TAPPS President or any other officer, and or any TAPPS ad hoc committee member for any and all expenses incurred for that defense;
- C. The TAPPS Executive Board shall suspend from participation in all TAPPS activities, for a period of one to three years, a student and/or TAPPS Member School, which, after receiving written notice, fails to reimburse TAPPS, TAPPS Executive Board Member, TAPPS President or any other officer, and/or any TAPPS ad hoc committee member, within 90 days, for all legal expenses incurred in defending a law suit or other legal action, including but not limited to a TRO.
