MEMBERSHIP IN TAPPS

A member school in good standing is defined as a private or parochial school as described in Article III of the TAPPS Constitution which has:

- A. returned its annual contract and paid its annual dues and fees by the deadline indicated on the current TAPPS calendar **(September 1)**;
- B. has met deadlines in submitting required forms and reports to district and state offices;
- C. has met obligations in regard to competition in scheduled contests;
- D. has followed the rules and guidelines of the TAPPS Constitution and By-Laws;
- E. has not been involved with litigation against TAPPS within the past five (5) years; and
- F. has been approved by an annual majority vote of the TAPPS Executive Board.

If a school voluntarily withdraws membership in TAPPS, the school must wait two realignment cycles before application for reinstatement in TAPPS.
