

# Section 58 Classification Based on Enrollment

2012**

- A. **ENROLLMENT.** Participant schools shall be assigned to a classification on the basis of an average enrollment of three dates from the previous two years. The formula used to determine enrollment shall be:
1. *Enrollment Dates.* Enrollment on September 1 of the previous even numbered year for grades 9-12; plus enrollment on February 1 of the previous school year for grades 9-12; plus two times the enrollment on September 1 of the current odd numbered year for grades 9-12; divided by four equals the average enrollment to determine classification for the next two year cycle, beginning in the Fall of the even numbered year. **Other formulas may be reviewed by the Executive Board for use in the classification process.**
  2. *Enrollment of New Participant School.* New schools shall be assigned to a classification based on 1) previous enrollment figures; 2) current enrollment; or 3) projected enrollment as determined by the Executive Board.
- B. **CLASSIFICATIONS (CLASSES).** Participating high schools shall be divided into classifications for the 2010-2011 and 2011-2012 school years according to the following enrollments:
