

A. ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS.

Only schools that are members of TAPPS as prescribed in Article III of the Constitution shall be eligible for the district meet. In order to be eligible to participate in the academic, art and music contests, schools must use TAPPS as the vehicle for its athletic competitions as well.

B. MEETS.

Competition shall extend to a state championship in the contests listed on the previous page.

C. DISTRICT/ REGIONS STRUCTURE.

District assignments shall be made after annual contracts are received at the TAPPS State Office on September 1st. Districts / Regions may be merged, rearranged, or renumbered.

D. ORGANIZING THE DISTRICT MEET.

The TAPPS office will name a temporary president for each district. He will call a meeting of all schools in the district to select the academic, art, and music district meet director and notify the TAPPS office of the selection no later than December 15, and notify the TAPPS State office;

E. DUTIES OF THE DISTRICT PRESIDENT.

The district meet director will enter the District / Regional results on TAPPSter by the certification deadlines shown.

F. DUTIES OF THE DISTRICT MEET PLANNING COMMITTEE

1. Select the site and date for the meet in accordance with the current TAPPS calendar by December 15;
2. Complete arrangements by February 1 for conducting the district meet;
3. Arrange the contest schedule;
4. Arrange for financing the meet; and
5. See that only those schools on the official list, furnished by the TAPPS office, are permitted to enter.
6. **A REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH DISTRICT MUST ATTEND THE JANUARY MEETING.**
