

- A. **SCHOOL ORGANIZATION.** Schools will be assigned to Regions when contracts are returned to the TAPPS State Office and fees are paid. Competitions are scheduled at the Region and State levels for music. (See TAPPS website www.tapps.net for your school Classification and Region assignment under the Fine Arts- Music Category.)
- B. **STATE CLASSIFICATION.** The Classifications are grouped as follows: **1A/2A/3A** and **4A/5A**. The State competition is held in Belton, Texas.
- C. **STATE MUSIC COMMITTEE.**
The State Music Executive Committee will coordinate the State Music Competitions and rule on challenges, exceptions, etc. The TAPPS Music Director will preside over the Executive Committee and the State Meeting held in the spring. The Assistant Music Coordinators will be elected each year at the spring TAPPS State Convention music divisional meeting.
- D. **REGION COORDINATOR** It will be the duty of the Region Coordinator from the previous year to appoint a new region coordinator unless he/she remains as the coordinator. If the past coordinator is no longer in the region, the State Music Coordinator shall appoint a new region coordinator. The Region Coordinators should appoint an assistant and secure a date and location for the competitions. This should be done by September 30. Region Coordinator duties are described in Section 244 and may be split among multiple people.
