

# Division I Wildcard

## Football Playoff Formula 2010-2011

The two (2) wildcard playoff spots will be determined by comparing the records of the 7<sup>th</sup> place team from Districts 1 and 2, the 4th place team from District 3, and El Paso Cathedral. The school with the highest point total will be awarded the spot. This point system is strictly based on wins. No points will be awarded for a loss. Points will be awarded for each win, the opponent will fit into the tables below and subsequent points awarded. The winning percentage will be based on the end of the regular season totals. See figure 1 (Public Schools or out of state schools will fit Texas UIL classification by size) and figure 2 (Private School or equivalent - Jesuit be size) for points:

In the event of a points tie:

- I. Head-to-Head game will be the first tie-breaker
- II. Record versus similar opponents will be the second tie-breaker
- III. Margin of victory against similar opponents will be the third  
Flip of the coin will be the last tie-breaker
