- _____ 12. Secure a copy of the **National Federation of High Schools** rules to be brought to each contest. TAPPS provides one copy for each school.
- _____ 13. Insure that the **Eligibility Form** is completed in TAPPSTER **before participation in the first game**. Any changes to the eligibility form are to be made in TAPPSTER.
- _____ 14. Each athlete has **Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form** (required annually) and **Student Acknowledgement of Rules Form** (www.tapps.net) on file.
- _____ 15. Prepare statistics and attend All District/District Certification meeting.
- _____ 16. Review ALL DISTRICT selection information on TAPPS website.
- _____ 17. Submit team roster and photo for state program by date shown on TAPPS calendar.
