- _____ 11. Insure that the **Eligibility Form** is completed in TAPPSTER **before participation in the first meet**. Any changes to the eligibility form are to be made in TAPPSTER.
- _____ 12. Each athlete has **Pre-Participation Physical Evaluation Form** (required annually) and **Student Acknowledgement of Rules Form** (www.tapps.net) on file.
- _____ 13. Complete the School /Team Registration on TAPPSTER.COM by the deadline shown on the TAPPS Calendar. (www.tappster.com)
- _____ 14. Print your Fees Form that is generated in www.tappster.com and bring payment for **Entry Fees** to the state meet.
- _____ 15. For any eligible student, complete and submit the Academic All State Form located on the TAPPS website. (www.tapps.net)
